City of Union to Honor Ryle Lady Raider Basketball with Raider Day

Union, KY, March 21- The City of Union Commission will recognize the 2019 Kentucky Sweet Sixteen State Championship Ryle High School Lady Raider Basketball team at the April 1 meeting.

The meeting and ceremony will begin at 6:30 p.m. at the regularly-scheduled commission meeting. The meeting will be held at the Warren S. Moore City Building located at 1843 Mt. Zion Road in Union, Kentucky.

The commission will present Head Coach Katie Haitz and the team members with a proclamation declaring Tuesday, April 2 as Lady Raider Basketball Day in the City of Union.

The commission encourages residents and businesses to wear orange, black or Raider-themed attire to recognize the team's achievement and to display signage supporting the team's success on April 2.

The Lady Raiders won their first ever state championship with a 63-48 victory over Pulaski Southwest in the title game. The team finished with a 33-5 overall record and three members of the team were named to the all-tournament squad with Maddie Scherr as Most Valuable Player.
