**Halloween Times Announced in Union For 2020**

The City Commission of Union has set the official Trick-or-Treat times for Halloween 2020 for Saturday, October 31, from 6 to 8 p.m.

Participation in the event, as always, is voluntary. Those homes wishing to participate should turn on their porch lights to indicate.

“We want our citizens to be safe, and participate in Halloween as they see prudent and acceptable,” said Mayor Larry K.
