

**CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-04**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE FOR
THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, the City of Union, Kentucky has created an Economic Development Committee by virtue of Ordinance 2009-012 to provide guidance and council to the Union City Commission regarding the future economic growth of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Committee currently consists of six (6) members; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to reduce the members to four (4) members; and

WHEREAS, the committee members for the Economic Development Committee shall consist of citizens of the City of Union, Kentucky or persons who own a business in the City of Union, Kentucky, and the person must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY
AS FOLLOWS:***

SECTION I

That the Economic Development Committee for the City of Union, Kentucky shall consist of four (4) members; said members being either a citizen of the City of Union, Kentucky, or persons who own a business in the City of Union, Kentucky. All new members shall be appointed by the Union City Commission and shall serve for a four (4) year term of appointment. The terms shall be staggered.

SECTION II

The current membership shall consists of Jim Collett, Angie Scroggins, Doug Dawson and Jamie Lyons. Jim Collett and Doug Dawson's terms shall run through December 31, 2023; and Angie Scroggins and Jamie Lyons' terms shall run through December 31, 2025.

SECTION III

That the Economic Development shall meet as needed at the request of the Mayor or
Commission Chair.

SECTION IV

All other Ordinances and/or Orders inconsistent with this Ordinance are ***HEREBY REPEALED.***

SECTION V

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
