CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Solomon called the Special Commission Meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

ROLL CALL

A quorum was present and a roll call was taken: Commissioner Doug Bine, Commissioner John Mefford, Commissioner Brian Garner, and Mayor Larry Solomon were all present. Commissioner Jeremy Ramage was absent.

Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget - Staff Salaries

Mayor Solomon explained the purpose for discussion was to discuss staff raises, this was the last item of the budget left open from the previous discussion at the Caucus meeting on April 24, 2023. Retaining good quality staff was of importance to the Commission when making a consideration for issuing raises. Staff raises are issued on a basis of job performance. After discussion the decision was made by the Commission to issue a six percent raise to current staff members who have been employed with the city six months or longer and meet required job performance reviews. Attorney Voss will prepare legislation to be read at the next Regular Commission meeting.

New Business Interest

Mayor Solomon mentioned a business showing interest in locating within the city but no commitment has been made. The location is at the corner of Mt. Zion Road and Bristow Drive. This would be a good location once Brilliance Avenue is extended as it would be a good connection and make it a walkable distance for the residents of Harmony neighborhood.

Mayor Solomon asked for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Garner made a motion and Commissioner Bine seconded that motion. **Motion approved 4-0**.
