CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE UNION CITY COMMISSION REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE 2024-10 PROHIBITING CANNABIS BUSINESSES OPERATING IN THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS the issue of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within the City of Union was placed on the ballot for this November 5th, 2024 election.

WHEREAS the citizens of Union voted in favor of allowing cannabis businesses to operate in the City of Union.

WHEREAS the Union City Commission wishes to repeal in its entirety Ordinance 2024-10.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE UNION CITY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the Union City Commission hereby *REPEALS ORDINANCE 2024-10* relating to the prohibition of cannabis businesses in the City of Union, Kentucky.

SECTION II

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to the law.
