**AN ORDINANCE OF THE UNION CITY COMMISSION REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY  
ORDINANCE 2024-10 PROHIBITING CANNABIS BUSINESSES OPERATING IN THE CITY  
OF UNION, KENTUCKY**

*WHEREAS* the issue of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within the City of Union was placed on the ballot for this November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 election.

*WHEREAS* the citizens of Union voted in favor of allowing cannabis businesses to operate in the City of Union.

*WHEREAS* the Union City Commission wishes to repeal in its entirety Ordinance 2024-10.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE UNION CITY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:***

**SECTION I**

That the Union City Commission hereby ***REPEALS ORDINANCE 2024-10*** relating to the prohibition of cannabis businesses in the City of Union, Kentucky.


**SECTION II**
