

<u>Position Title:</u> Public Works Laborer

SUMMARY

The Public Works Seasonal Laborer is responsible for general maintenance duties, landscaping care, property clean-up, and assisting with public works projects as directed. This is a part-time position.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the supervision of the Public Works Director, the Seasonal Public Works Laborer will:

- Assist in the areas of street, property, and landscape maintenance including, but not limited to
 - Pothole repairs
 - Property checks
 - Right-of-ways clean up and sign removal
 - Trash cleanup
 - Weeding
 - Flower and tree pruning/care
 - Planting trees, plants, flowers, etc.
- Operate light vehicles, small landscaping equipment, and/or power tools.
- Move supplies and equipment as directed.
- Assist with setup, tear down, and the operation of city events and functions.
- Work indoors and outdoors.
- All other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum age of 18 years.
- High School Diploma or GED minimum.
- Experience with property maintenance, landscaping, and similar.
- Ability to photograph and provide general reports/updates.
- Good written and oral communications skills.
- Ability to establish harmonious working relationships with citizens, other employees, contractors, and elected officials.
- Possess a valid Kentucky Driver's License.
- Consent to criminal background check.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS
