As you may have noticed, the 70+ trees the city planted in November are starting to spring to life! Mt. Zion Rd and US 42 will continue to look better as this recent planting gets established. The wood supports will stay in place for several more months until we're confident the trees are ready to be on their own.

Union Town Square- We are preparing the property for our future park and city building. Actions taken this month include preparing environmental reports and completing required permits. We're also removing excess debris from the southwest corner of the property in preparation of general earthmoving later this year.

Street Preparation- We continue to prepare streets for repaving this calendar year. Contracts should be signed this month with repaving planned for Lincoln Ct, Natchez, Richmond (south), Arbor Springs (east), Braxton (east) Cherbourg (north), and Sweet Harmony between US42 and Cobalt Way.

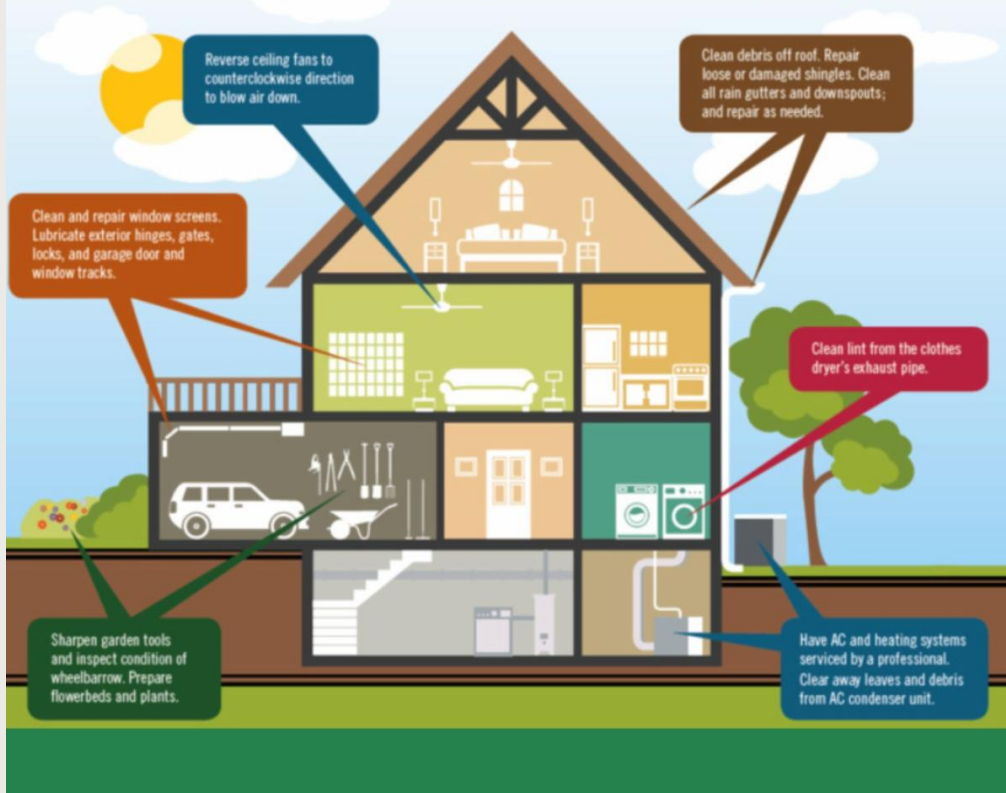
