Three prizes will be awarded to the top winners. Share your best shots!

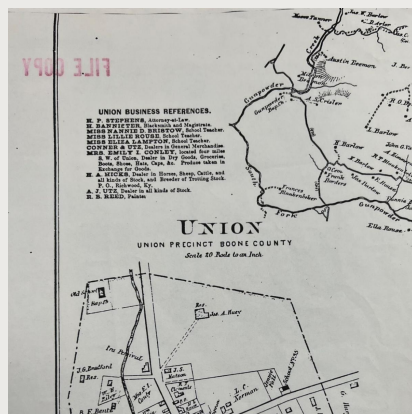

Historically Uniquely Union

Union has a rich history. Here, we are taking a look back at newsworthy articles and fun facts about Union. Click the link for a video given by Bruce Ferguson in 2004.

He discusses many historical facts about Union, like how the area was wilderness, with pioneers having to clear land and build homes from timber. One of the earliest settlers was Jacob Fowler, who purchased the land around Union from a land speculator, Humphrey Marshall. There is also the story of Hugh Steers, an Irish immigrant and Revolutionary soldier, who escaped capture during the war and eventually settled in Union, with his grave still present near the clubhouse of Lassing Green golf course.

Another tale of Merriweather Lewis being the first traveler along the buffalo trail that later became the toll road that runs through Tadpole Lane, and one time through where Ryle High School is located.

Union Town Square

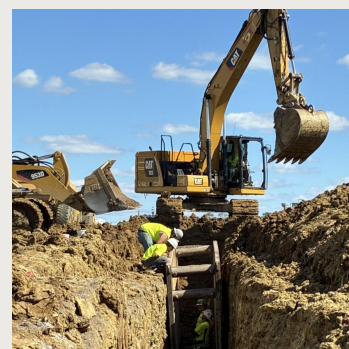
Progress continues on our future city building and park at Union Town Square.
