Tax Time Is Around The Corner.

2025 Tax rates are now posted on our website. Union's General Government revenue consists solely of Ad Valorem (Property) and Tangible Property Taxes. These tax revenues fund the services required by our citizens, such as street maintenance, street lighting, and refuse collection. The City's 2025 tax rates are:

Property Tax Rate-
\$.201 per \$100 Assessed Valuation on all Real Property for 2025 from .204 per \$100 in 2024 &
\$.222 per \$100 Assessed Valuation on all Tangible Personal Property.

Available for residents aged 65 and over, the Homestead Exemption reduces your property taxes. To learn more about this exemption or to apply, visit the Boone County PVA website. Homestead Application must be submitted during the year in which the exemption is sought to the Boone County Property Valuation Administrator.

Amounts will be due and payable as follows:

- If paid by October 31 – get 2% discount.
- If Paid in November or December – Base Amount due.
- If Paid after December 31 – 10% penalty and 1% interest.
- Delinquent on January 1
