December Public Works Updates



Union Town Square

Since the last update, we completed the future city building's north side foundation wall and started its underground utilities. Our contractor also

Construction related to Old Union Road in Union, KY, involves modern developments like the Union Town Square project (groundbreaking Aug 2025) and the older general store site at US 42/Old Union. Still, the original road likely developed organically from early settlement paths in the 1800s, connecting settlements, with the town established by 1838 and the area around US 42/Old Union becoming a key spot by the early 1900s for commerce, preceding modern development plans. Key Historical Context:

- Early Settlement (1800s): The area was part of the Fowler family land, with Union established by 1838 as a connection point for salt distribution from Big Bone Lick.
- Early Commerce (1850s-1900s): A general store and post office were located at the intersection of Mt.
 Zion Road and what became Old Union Rd (then part of US 42), indicating the road's importance.
- Modern Planning (2000): The 2000 Union Town Plan formally identified the area including Old Union Road as the Union Town Center for future development.

Recent & Future Development:

- Union Town Square (Ongoing): A major project including a park and city building, with a groundbreaking in August 2025, centered around this historic area.
- Union Promenade (2021): A large mixed-use development approved between US 42 and Old Union Road, further shaping the corridor.

In essence, Old Union Road has evolved from an old settlement path to a significant commercial and development corridor, with its construction history stretching back to the 19th century, formalized by 20th-century planning, and seeing major revitalization in the 2020s.

completed the base course of the east side parking lot, allowing us to continue progress during the winter months. Next steps include finishing the underground utilities and then preparing the ground for the city building's concrete slab, which will hopefully be completed later this month (weather dependent).
